## **Social and Emotional Foundations for Learning (SEFL): All Inclusive Training**

### **Module 2: Environment, Routine and Strategies**

Do you want to see more positive and fewer challenging behaviors in your child care and early learning program? Discover how consistent routines and fun, meaningful activities can improve those opportunities. Learn how to plan activities that build social and emotional development and promote teacher-child interactions. After this session, you will know how to design your environment, schedule, and routines to help support a child's social and emotional development.

### **Module 4: Promoting Children's Success through Social and Emotional Learning Techniques**

Do you want to learn more techniques that support social and emotional development, even when children are displaying challenging behaviors? This module identifies strategies, such as problem solving and games to teach children emotional literacy and emotional regulation. You will see your classroom transform, as you help children identify emotions and teach them positive social skills that foster friendships. In this session you will learn about the third level of the CSEFEL teaching pyramid, which represents *Targeted Social Emotional Supports*.

## **Supervision of Children**

This training reviews the current State of Missouri licensing requirements for staff to child ratio in various child care settings. Active supervision is reviewed, and techniques are presented to assist the early learning professional in providing active supervision at all times. The six strategies for Active Supervision are reviewed along with a section on child elopement. This course is suitable for family child care, as well as programs or centers.

### **Unit 4: Helping Parents and Providers Understand Temperament**

A child's temperament influences not only his or her style of interaction but the very way in which he or she understands and experiences the world. This unit provides child care professionals with an introduction to the concept of temperament and to key developmental traits.

Discover the difference between child-and teacher-directed activities. We will describe intentional teaching and help you learn how to communicate the benefits of play to families.

Building relationships with children is not a one-size-fits-all process. Learn how to communicate trust and concern for all children through the power of positive interactions. Discover how to interact with children in ways that make every moment count. Learn the benefits children receive through positive relationships, and all the ways nonverbal children develop a trusting and caring relationship with

What makes you a professional? You are defined by what you do, what you say and how you present yourself to the world. Discover that child care and early learning is a profession and, like other professions, it has a code of ethical conduct that everyone in the field should follow.

What have the infants or toddlers you work with told you today? Did you know that infants “talk” through crying and other non-verbal communications? Learn how temperament, challenging behaviors and cultural traditions can shape how an infant or toddler will communicate. This session will also share how to discover the communication and meaning of behaviors such as biting and tantrums.
