Okay, so you may not be wearing a cape but there's no doubt in my mind that you can save the day for someone **today!**

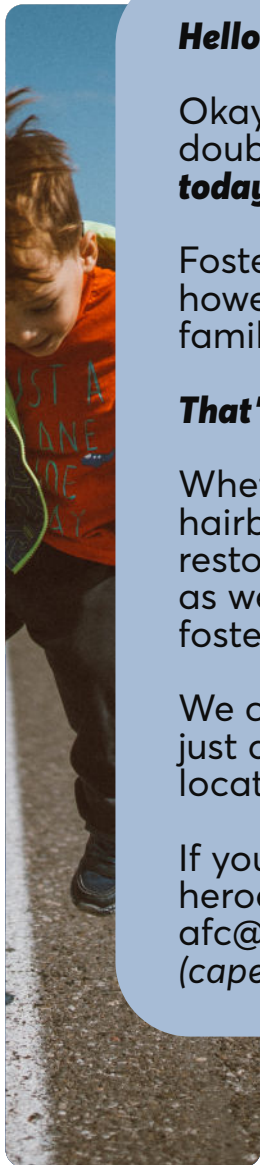
Foster care families have all of the same needs we have, however, some only have a few hours notice before their families grow by a few members.
